Founding Property Owners, Managers & Developers

The Cincinnati 2030 District is a collaborative effort to create a network of healthy, high-performing buildings in Cincinnati. Property owners will not be required to achieve the goals of the District by legislative mandates, or as individual buildings. Rather, we will do so collectively because full participation in the District brings collaboration, shared resources, and innovative solutions that will lead to cost savings, healthier buildings, and a more livable, desirable city. This, in turn, helps Cincinnati attract and retain a high caliber workforce and new entrepreneurial talent.

- 50% reduction in energy use for existing buildings, and carbon neutral for new buildings, by 2030
- 50% reduction in water use by 2030
- 50% reduction in transportation emissions by 2030
- Improvements in occupant health and wellness (specific metrics in development)
